- 8. DASH update. Pete Karlson continues his work at hand harvesting the milfoil. So far he has collected 5100# of milfoil!! He needs volunteers!!

- 10. Kevin gave a summary of the UW Stevens Point report of the lakes water quality from samples obtained in May. Quality is good. There was an uptick of phosphorous in Pine Lake.
